Baldomir represents a turning point in our history. It is the result of a patient journey, born from experience, learning, and evolution— both in the vineyard and in the winery. A wine that is never rushed.

Its origin marks a moment of inflection: when we felt we had reached a certain level of maturity, we understood we were ready to present a wine that embodies everything we had learned. With a well-established winery and a sharper understanding of our terroir, Baldomir was born.

The name pays tribute to the maiden name of Herminda, Don Martino's wife. A woman of aristocratic origin, she brought with her a strong sense of refinement and high standards of quality that deeply shaped the family's spirit and the style of the winery. In her honor, we refer to this line as "grandmother's jewels": exceptional wines, crafted only when the harvest reaches truly outstanding levels.

Baldomir doesn't follow a commercial logic or a fixed schedule— it follows a conviction: it is only made when the quality fully justifies it. It is a wine born of experience, of time, and of a deep commitment to the very best our land can offer.
